

Forward notice of amendment to criteria for 2012 and 2013 lists:-

At the Joint meeting of all 7 UK Border Terrier Clubs on 1 May 2010, the Clubs agreed that from the July 2012 lists (to be prepared by our Judges Sub Committee at the beginning of 2012), the requirements for people to have passed the following assessments will apply to NEW APPLICANTS to the 2012 B List for Breed Specialists as well as to A3 list Breed Specialist applicants.

From the 2013 lists, it will apply to ALL applicants to the Breed Specialists B lists as well as the A3 lists.

From next year, the following wording will therefore be added to the above B List criteria for Breed Specialists:-

- To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer, and passed the relevant examination on the Kennel Club Regulations and Judging Procedures (currently KC. Policy for A3 list Breed Specialist applicants). To apply to **new applicants** for 2012 B List for Breeds Specialists and **all applicants** for 2013 B Lists for Breed Specialists.
- To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer on Conformation and Movement (currently K.C. Policy for A3 list Breed Specialist applicants). To apply to **new applicants** for 2012 B List for Breeds Specialists and **all applicants** for 2013 B Lists for Breed Specialists.
- To have attended a seminar given by a Kennel Club Accredited Trainer and passed the "Hands on" assessment of judges' knowledge of Conformation and Movement, covering Points of the Dog, The Structure of the Dog and The Conventional Measurements of the Dog (currently K.C. Policy for A3 list Breed Specialist applicants). To apply to **new applicants** for 2012 B List for Breeds Specialists and **all applicants** for 2013 B Lists for Breed Specialists.
